Fundraising 2023

Overview of needs (why we need to raise funds)

- **Operational Costs to maintain current Pitch** (~\$20,000)
 - Funded through player dues
- Field fund/ field security
 - Field improvement and long term field plan(purchase property)
- Capital Investments and club operations costs (\$6,000)
 - Website
 - TeamSnap
 - Equipment (Lights, scrum sleds, shed)
- Gary Smith Scholarship (\$3k)
 - Funded through 2SP



Fundraising Strategies for 2023

Building the DRFC community

- Field fund/ field security (currently at \$20k in 3 years)
 - \$2k per month in recurring donations (\$24k per year)
 - Club wide merchandise sales
 - Spring/Fall home match weekends
 - Possible summers 7s Tournament
- Capital investments(pitch lights, scrum sleds, shed)
 - Person-person ask(i.e. Raising money for new posts from the Ancient Dragons)
 - Club wide merchandise sales
 - Spring/Fall home match weekends
- DRFC board operational costs
 - Schwabby and Verizon
 - Pull from other fundraisers



Fundraising Strategies for 2023

- Grow the Committee
 - We need Volunteers!
 - To support campaigns,
 - To reach out to companies and other organizations
- Short Term Small Fundraisers
 - Minor surplus from events and merchandise
 - Program sponsorship with DRFC Community companies
- Create mid-term and long-term Capital Campaigns
 - DRFC website: Connect-friends of DRFC-Capital campaign
 - Building for the future options with subscription plan (recurring donations)
